





OF SPONSORSHIP

For 35 years, LCW has been sharing love, giving help, bringing hope, and changing lives through sponsorship. It is incredible to reflect on the years and the lives that have been changed because people like you gave. We are so grateful for the past 35 years!

The sponsorship program began in 1987 with just a few children receiving rice assistance for \$30 a month along with the other HELP programs. Word began to spread all over the world and people from the USA, Canada, Europe, and Asia began sponsoring children and giving to LCW.





In 2001, Glenna Waller and Lee Betts began the College program for sponsored children to be able to receive a college education, and by 2002, LCW was celebrating its 15th anniversary. By 2005 sponsorship numbers had reached 500 and the first college graduates were coming through the program. The Little Children of the Philippines communities were growing and more people were given a chance for a better future with the help of generous sponsors and donors!

Throughout the 2010s, programs continued to grow steadily and sponsorships reached 700 and the college program saw over 200 graduates. Now, at 35 year of service, LCW has over 850 sponsored children with sponsors from 37 US states and 13 countries on 5 continents! All-time, over 3,800 children have been sponsored. We can boast 350 college graduates, 97% of whom are working and the other 3% have chosen to become full-time parents.

LCW has always been committed to a holistic mission to reach needs of the whole person—physical, spiritual, and educational. We opted to change the name of this newsletter from SS Sponsorship, which originated from the founders playing off the naming of ships (sponsor–ship), to Hand in Hand to celebrate 35 years of sponsorship and to capture the helping hand relationship that sponsorship represents. Thank you for a wonderful 35 years, and here's to 35 more years of changing lives! You have made a difference far beyond anything we could quantify in this newsletter. Thank you!

SPONSORSHIP = RELATIONSHIP

BEN MARIE GAÑALON & ANNA LEE SNEED ■

Ben Marie is a smart and strong women who just graduated with her BS in Criminology from Negros Oriental Statue University in July of 2022. However, she, like many of our sponsored children, started out as a small, thin little girl whose family was struggling to get by and provide their basic needs. They could not afford her school uniforms and supplies for her education and it was difficult just to put 3 meals on the table. Ben Marie did what she could to help her parents without complaint, but her future was uncertain at the time.

In 2007, when Ben Marie was just 7 years old, that's when things began to change. Anna Lee Sneed began sponsoring Ben Marie. She was so happy to be sponsored and she was curious about how being a sponsored child would affect her future. Even at the young age of 7, Ben Marie understood the difficulties of poverty and how sponsorship could change that.

Anna Lee and Ben Marie began exchanging letters sharing about themselves. Slowly they began to get to know each other by receiving each others letters, pictures, packages, and more. Ben Marie always shared about her letters about her studies, achievements, and about her family. Despite the distance between the US and the Philippines, the two created a bond.

Ben Marie was an outstanding student all through Elementary and High School. She was an active member at LCP joining the choir, praise team, sports, evangelism, and more. She was granted a college scholarship by Dwight and Lori Henderson, and continued to perform well at LCP and in school. As a criminology student, she graduated as a Advanced Cadet Officer in Army ROTC and reached the rank of Major (S7) and is now a GMA/reservist (Sgt).

Anna Lee continued sponsoring Ben Marie and growing their bond throughout her education. Now that Ben Marie has graduated, Anna Lee's time as her sponsor is coming to an end, but the relationship they share will live on forever. Ben Marie is a successful young woman and we are confident she will be successful in her working life. Sponsorship, and the relationship that comes with it, changed both of their lives in a way that is so much greater than just \$35 per month—it gave love, help, and hope to them both!

SHELTER MATCHING FUNDS

Our shelters house as many as 75 children at a time. These kids come from very difficult situations of abuse and/or neglect, but at LCP, they know they are loved and their needs will be met. With so many children to care for, the shelters have some of the highest budgets at LCP. We are in need of help to be able to meet all the shelter budgets this year

Sponsors, we are so grateful to have you be a part of LCW and for your investment in a child's life and education. Here are a few reminders & updates for the rest of the year:

- We are still in the process of changing our systems in the office. You may notice some changes of our name on your credit card statement, different receipts, and other small adjustments. If you have any questions about anything you receive from LCW, please call our office at 770-358-2771 or email info@littlechildren.org.
- School will be starting back in person beginning in August or September! We are so excited for the kids to be able to be back in the classroom and to see their friends again. If you would like to send a monetary back to school gift for things like supplies, new uniforms, shoes, etc., please have it to our office by August 10 to be sure it is in the August wire for distribution prior to the first day of school.
- You should receive your Child Annual Progress Report in the mail by the end of September. This is a great way to see how your child is doing and what their needs are.
- Health Insurance is so helpful to sponsored families in case anyone gets sick or needs hospitalization.
 Health Insurance is \$104 per year per family. If you would like your sponsored child to have Health Insurance for 2023, payments are due by November 10.
- Christmas is such a special time. Many of you like to send Christmas gifts to your sponsored children and their families. Due to the delays in shipping, we have already sent our Christmas boxes. If you would like to send items in our boxes, they will not arrive by Christmas this year. If you would like to send monetary gifts for Christmas or money for Christmas gifts to be purchased in the Philippines, please submit them by November 10 to be sure they are distributed by Christmas.
