#### A Founder's Reflections: Dr. Bettie Elwood



At 94 years old, Dr. Bettie Elwood, also known as Nanay, is the last living founder of Little Children of the World. Her co-founders Dr. Doug Elwood, Dean Houk, Peggy Houk, and Luther Carroll have all passed away in recent years, but their legacy lives on through the program they helped create.

Bettie fondly remembers her experiences in the Philippines and the early days of the ministry. During their visit, Carmenia and her daughter Carmela, who was sponsored by the Elwood Family from preschool through college, were able to visit with Nanay. Carmela now has her Master's degree and is a teacher here in the US. It was a beautiful reunion of old friends where they reflected on the impact of the ministry that was started 38 years ago with just a few little boys sleeping on the streets that has now grown to sponsor over 925 children and the HELPS programs and reaches over 6000 people through various aspects of the ministry.

In amazement of the current scope of the ministry, Bettie said, "I'm just so glad we could get it started." Her humility and vision continue to shine through. Without the founders' willingness to answer God's call, how different would the world be? How many people would still be waiting for an opportunity to escape from the grips of poverty?

Carmenia reminded Nanay that she saw something in her before she even had an education. Nanay once told Carmenia, "If you have the heart, you can serve. God will equip you." Since then, Carmenia finished her college education through the college program and since then has been the Executive Director of the entire Philippine program for 27 years! Even today, Carmenia holds onto these prolific words when she is overwhelmed or needs a boost.

The story of LCW's foundation and how it continues to flourish is a reminder that God will work through you if you just allow Him. All 5 founders were retired from their primary careers when they started the journey of starting LCW, Carmenia was a beneficiary before she took on her working role at LCP, and God continues to use ordinary people to do His work. Whatever God is calling you to do, you are equipped for it in Jesus' name! We only need to say 'yes!'

# The Impact of Health & Housing

We believe in the biblical mandate of meeting practical needs for people. Health and Housing are critical needs that must be met before education can be a priority and meeting those needs in Jesus' name helps spread the love of Christ.

Medical consultations are available every Sunday with 2 doctors and 1 dentist. Between January and July, 713 patients saw doctors, 45 saw a dentist, and each week 65 underweight children received feeding supplements. Two families benefitted from a Bayanihan where the communities came together to rebuild their house, and the 5 residential shelters are currently housing 72 children from crisis situations. These are just a few of the Health and Housing statistics displaying the impact of our programs.

Good health and a safe home are blessings often overlooked or taken for granted until they become uncertain. A year-end contribution to Urgent Needs can help sustain these programs for the future to continue to provide vital health and housing services to people in need. ## **Holiday Giving Reminders**



2024 has flown by! Christmas will be here before we know it, so here are some reminders for holiday giving:

- Christmas gifts need to be received by our office by December 9 in order to arrive by Christmas. If they are submitted after 12/9, do not worry, they will still be sent this year, but they may be distributed after Christmas Day.
- All sponsors should have received the Child Annual Progress Report via mail. New sponsors who started between August and November will receive your first report next year.
- All end-of-ear giving must be done by December 31 for fiscal year 2024.

# **New Gifts Policy**

It is one of our greatest joys to be able to provide a personalized sponsorship experience. We love to be able to facilitate a relationship wherein you are able to give special gifts to your sponsored child and their family on holidays and special occasions. We understand and accept the administrative work and costs that are associated with making this possible. However, we must not allow the cost of facilitating individual gifts to affect the implementation of all the HELPS programs for the sake of gifts to individuals.

We have previously never taken administrative fees from gifts, because we want special blessings for Christmas, birthdays, and other occasions to have a maximum impact for your child. You may have noticed on our online forms there is a check box or over the phone our staff ask you if you are willing to cover the credit card fees for your contribution. We are so grateful to everyone who is willing to do this. Where it may only add a small amount to your payment, it hugely helps our organization! If you do not cover the cost processing that card for that gift, we have to fundraise it elsewhere as a Stateside Expense and that gift will only benefit your child.

Did you know we are charged a fee for every credit card transaction to the tune of over \$16,000 per year for gifts?

The Board of Directors decided, going forward, we will continue to give you the option to cover the credit card fee on our web donation forms as well as on the phone, but if you opt out, we will cover the cost of that fee from the gift itself on gifts to individuals. This policy only affects individual gifts (i.e. Christmas, birthday, school needs, repairs, etc.), not all contributions to programs. To avoid the fee altogether, you may pay by check. Again, we are overwhelmingly grateful to you for giving special gifts to your sponsored child and for all you do for our programs. We will continue to keep costs low and administrative fees at a minimum. #### **Peace & Faith this Christmas Season**



We know that Jesus is the reason for the season! We strive to keep Him at the center of everything we do. The Peace and Faith Program is our largest and most foundational program that emphasizes spreading the love of God to all who come into contact with our ministry. This program facilitates the weekly worship service and Sunday school for over 2000 people and the Bible studies in the communities for parents and youth. During the holiday season, the Peace and Faith Program works extra hard to be sure all feel the love and blessings of Christ.

While there's no turkey in their celebration, Little Children of the Philippines recently had Thanksgiving Sunday. This is a special Sunday worship service where thousands gather to worship and give thanks to God for another year of life and provision. The Peace and Faith Program facilitated communion and the members of the communities brought offerings of whatever they had to give back to God. Through the offering, the communities gave close to \$500 plus many fresh fruits, eggs, and other offerings to give glory back to God. Community offerings go back to support the members of the communities when there are bereaved members or other instances of great need because they are part of a caring community.

As our largest program, it has a correspondingly large budget to be sure everyone that receives any aspect of support from our ministry has the opportunity to hear about Jesus, including supporting the transportation costs for all sponsored kids and their parents to come to church.
