40 people accepted Christ as their Savior in November at LCP. Praise the Lord!

Every day, we strive hard to meet the basic needs of nearly 10,000 people by giving them access to resources that provide shelter, food, clothing, and education. This is a noble cause, and one we do not take lightly. However, if we meet physical needs, but fail to meet spiritual needs, then we miss out on sharing the Greatest Gift of all. Sharing the Love of Christ is the undertone for all our programs and services. Only eternity will tell the true impact of Jesus in so many lives.

From November 1-16, Chinelle Flood, LCW Executive Assistant, traveled to Dumaguete with the purpose of sharing a Bible study in all 15 communities. The Peace and Faith Program offers Bible studies every week for parents in each of our communities. This is an opportunity for Christian discipleship in a small group and also for fellowship and community building. Each week, people are given the opportunity to learn more about God and grow in their relationship with Christ.

Responding to Typhoon Tino

Typhoon Tino devastated the Philippines earlier this month leaving many dead, injured, and missing and even more people lost their homes and sources of livelihood. Thankfully, although the storm hit Negros Oriental hard, the island where LCP operates, our people and facilities were spared. However, our hearts broke for our fellow islanders and neighbors. LCP responded with emergency food packages for the 40 displaced families in the hardest hit portion of Canlaon City. We were blessed to be able to join the relief efforts along with hundreds of other NGOs, emergency response personnel, local government officials, and generous individuals reaching out a helping hand to the victims of this terrible storm. Our hearts and prayers stay with all the people in the Philippines who have been affected by typhoons and other calamities like this in 2025.



Mail Troubles

We have been experiencing severe delays with the mail. Correspondence via mail has been difficult which has produced some challenges for our office. We have received many reports that most people did not receive their 3rd quarter Jericho Street Echoes mailing. In addition, the last batch of child letters was held up in US Customs for 3 months. Unfortunately, these delays are out of our control and have negatively affected giving throughout the second half of the year. LCW must raise funds for all these programs to uplift the success of sponsorship.

Your gift to Urgent Needs today will help provide a safe and loving place to live in our Residential Dorms for up to 75 children, provides medications, physical therapy, doctors assessments for 205 Children with Disabilities, helps feed 125 hungry children in the Soup Kitchens, offers a free Health Clinic providing a doctor and nurse for accidents and sickness, as well as free medication, gives an opportunity for a good foundation for public school in LCP's 7 Preschools located in our poorest communities serving around 110 little children, and a College Program that is helping, with the help of many sponsors, 157 students to further their education through college, and through the Peace and Faith Program affords a way for over 2000 people to be able to come to LCP for Worship and Sunday School every Sunday, as well as weekly Bible Study in each community, to learn more about Jesus. All these programs enhance the lives of thousands of people, and Urgent needs will help cover the deficits from all of these programs. None of this is possible without your help.

We are also approaching 1000 sponsored children and with more kids and their families, we have more expenses in all our programs, but your gifts are also making a greater impact as we expand!
